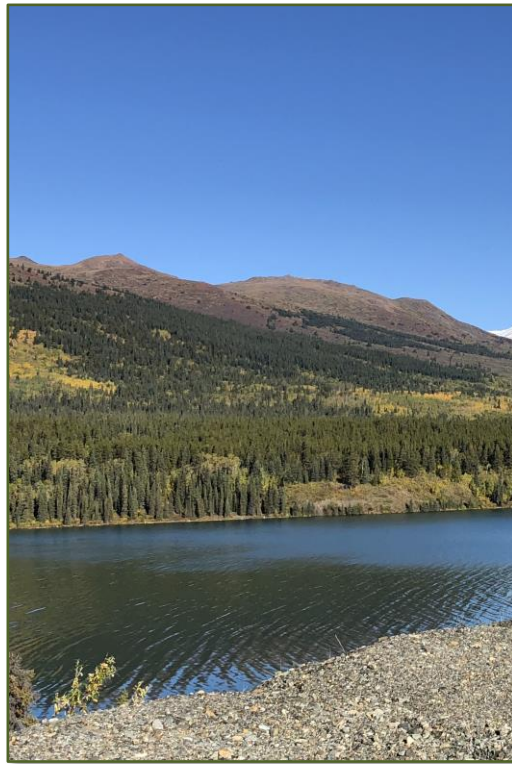




# MRP Dispute Resolution Model

*Resource Guide*



## **PURPOSE**

The Centre of Excellence for Matrimonial Real Property (COEMRP) has developed two on-reserve Matrimonial Real Property Dispute Resolution Models: one for use where First Nations hold real property in accordance with the *Indian Act* or a Land Code, and the other for use where First Nations hold real property in accordance with customary or traditional land holdings. Each Dispute Resolution Model also has a corresponding Workbook to aid First Nations in developing their dispute resolution process.

The Matrimonial Real Property Dispute Resolution Resource Guide (Resource Guide) has been developed to provide First Nations with a list of additional resources that they may wish to review and consult to learn more about matrimonial real property on-reserve and dispute resolution processes.
